



# The Tibet Fund Call for Proposals

## from Tibetan Civil Society Organizations

The Tibet Fund (TTF) is pleased to announce an opportunity for Tibetan non-governmental organizations in India and Nepal to take part in the 2019 Tibetan Civil Society and Community Empowerment Program (TCSCEP). TTF invites local Tibetan organizations that address critical community needs and provide high quality community services in the fields of education, health, sustainable livelihoods, women empowerment, and cultural preservation to apply for small grants from \$5,000 to \$25,000 per grant.

TCSCEP aims to increase the effectiveness, impact, and sustainability of local organizations that fill gaps between critical community needs and existing services, and empower local community members, in particular Tibetan youth, to serve their communities, improve lives, and make social change. TTF believes vibrant civil societies contribute to social and economic development and that strong local organizations will be critical for Tibetan communities to face new challenges of the 21st century.

Organizations should align their proposals with TTF's mission of preserving the distinct cultural and national identity of the Tibetan people and promoting self-reliance and cohesiveness of the exile Tibetan community. Along with small grants, TTF will provide training, mentoring, and organizational development support to selected organizations to help them become more effective at achieving their respective goals. Applicant organizations should have potential to become multi-year partners of TTF, to scale up their organizational capacity and impact, and should not be limited to a single individual.

### Proposals should ideally include:

a) Evidence-based solution to a problem, need, or challenge that is well aligned with TTF's mission and goals; b) Clear, detailed information about the proposed project activities, intended beneficiaries, and expected measurable impact; c) Information about the organization's management and financial structure demonstrating it can successfully deliver the project.
