



The Tibet Fund Call for Proposals from Overseas Shichak Support Organizations

The Tibet Fund (TTF) is pleased to announce an opportunity for overseas Tibetan Shichak Support organizations (TSSO) that are supporting settlement-based projects in India and Nepal to take part in the Tibetan Shichak Support Initiative (TSSI). TTF invites TSSOs to apply for matching grants from Rupees 250,000 to Rupees 700,000 per grant to support projects focusing on education, health, sustainable livelihoods, or other critical needs in their respective settlements in India and Nepal

This is a matching grant program that aims to encourage Tibetans in the West to participate in the overall development of their settlements and contribute in making them vibrant and sustainable by supporting their critical needs. The Tibet Fund sees this initiative as building upon and reinforcing the community-based work already under way in the settlements.

TSSO should align their proposals with TTF's goal of promoting self-reliance and cohesiveness of the exile Tibetan community. Along with small grants, TTF will provide support to selected organizations to help them become more effective at achieving their respective goals. Applicants should be Shichak organizations located outside South Asia.

How the Matching Grant works:

The Tibet Fund will offer a matching grant up to Rs. 700,000 for a project that aligns with our goal to strengthen Tibetan settlements in South Asia. For instance, for a project with a budget of Rs.1,400,000, if an organization raises Rs.700,000, we will make a matching grant of Rs. 700,000. If the project cost is more than Rs.1,400,000, TTF will make a grant of Rs. 700,000 only. Project size should not be less than Rs. 500,000, including the TTF matching grant of Rs. 250,000. Matching grants will not be considered for scholarships, stipends or assistance to needy individuals.

Proposals should ideally include:

a) Evidence-based solution to a problem, need, or challenge that is well aligned with TTF's mission and goals; b) Clear, detailed information about the proposed project activities, intended beneficiaries, and expected measurable impact; c) Information about the organization and d) Settlement Office's endorsement of the project.

Instructions for applying:
